Art Curriculum Overview

EYFS

Expressive art and design is one of the seven areas of the EYFS framework.

From Year 1 through to Year 6 we will implement a two-year rolling programme that covers six units of art. This will give the children the opportunity to re-visit units three times to build on their skills and ensure progression through the subject.

Year A

Key Stage 1 - Painting

The children will learn about primary and secondary colours, including mixing. They will be given opportunities to practise different painting techniques and brush control.

Key Stage 2 – Painting

The children will continue to build their knowledge of colour mixing by shading and blending colours. They will also begin to add texture and pattern using paint.

Key Stage 1 – Clay

The children will be given opportunities to roll clay and cut it using templates. They will learn how to use tools to add pattern and texture. They will also be given the opportunity to return to painting and use their skills to paint their sculptures.

Key Stage 2 – Clay

The children will build on the skills taught in KS1 with clay. They will also develop their skills by creating more patterns and textures. Children will learn the new skills of score and slip which will allow them to join pieces of clay together to create more intricate pieces of art. This again, will be combined with painting skills from previous units.

Key Stage 1 – Print

The children will experiment with different methods of printing, including rubbing, relief work and creating patterns with a variety of objects.

Key Stage 2 - Print

The children will continue to print with a growing range of objects. They will further develop their skills in relief and impressed printing and explore mono-printing.

Year B

The art and design units to be covered in the second year of the programme are currently under development.

Throughout all the units of art, the children will build a portfolio in their sketch books, which will record the practise, design process, creativity and evaluations. During the units the children will study artists linked with the style of art being taught.
