- If you feel you or your child would benefit from pastoral support please contact Miss Jordan

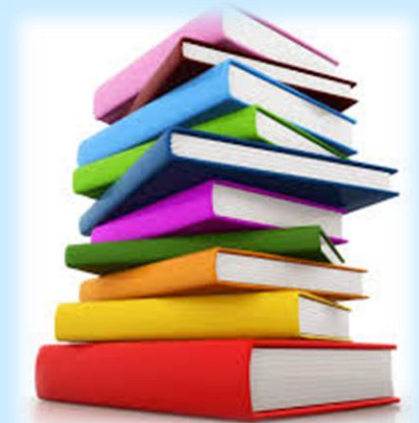
Uniform

- Stud earrings and a watch (removed for PE)



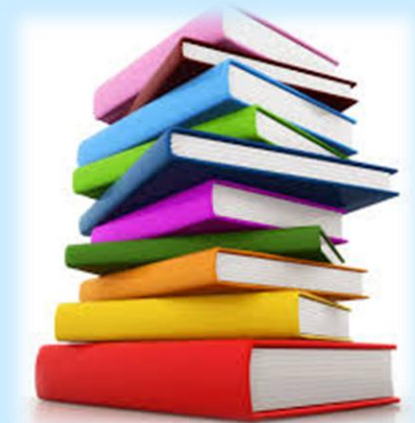
Reading

- Key priority this year – Summerville Year of Reading
- Children who read regularly and widely achieve better in school
- Reading every night – 10 minutes
- Question your child on the book
- Note in their diary – book changed daily if read
- Read stories in class every day
- Guided reading – twice a week
- Interventions
- Phonics



Reading cont.

- Use their finger to track the words (if on pink/red/yellow book band)
- If your child gets stuck ask them to look at the pictures, look at what the word starts with, read the sentence again
- Share stories at bath time/bedtime
- Discuss stories with your child
- Read everything you can – street signs, road signs, shop signs
- Enjoy reading!

Writing

- The focus in Year 1 is getting the children to write full sentences – with a **capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop**. We encourage the children to use their phonics – i.e. Cat c-a-t.
- Write the shopping list
- Write to the tooth fairy/Santa
- Write a postcard to friends or family
- Keep a holiday diary



Maths

- In Maths we are focusing on Place value
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Saying one more or one less than a number.
- Lots of counting
- Paying in shops with money
- Talking mathematically – “Do you want more sweets?”



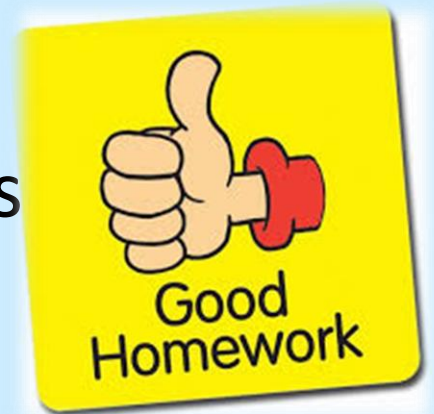
Homework

PE

The Daily Mile

- At least three times a week children & staff run, walk or jog around the playground for 15 minutes
- Children do not get changed but we make sure they have suitable footwear
- It's non competitive: no one is first or last
- All children succeed, regardless of age or personal circumstances
- The Daily Mile meets the needs of childhood: **Fun, friends, freedom and fresh air**

Food and Drink

- All children in Y1 are entitled to FSM
- Packed lunches – healthy packed lunches & plain water
- Morning snack – fruit or vegetables only – children can access snack at playtime
- Milk – letter from the office to request milk (there is a charge unless your child is on FSM)



Pupil Premium Funding

- School receives £1320 for every child entitled to free school meals
- This funding provides Place2Be, additional staff, trips and resources to support all children in school
