Food and drink in school

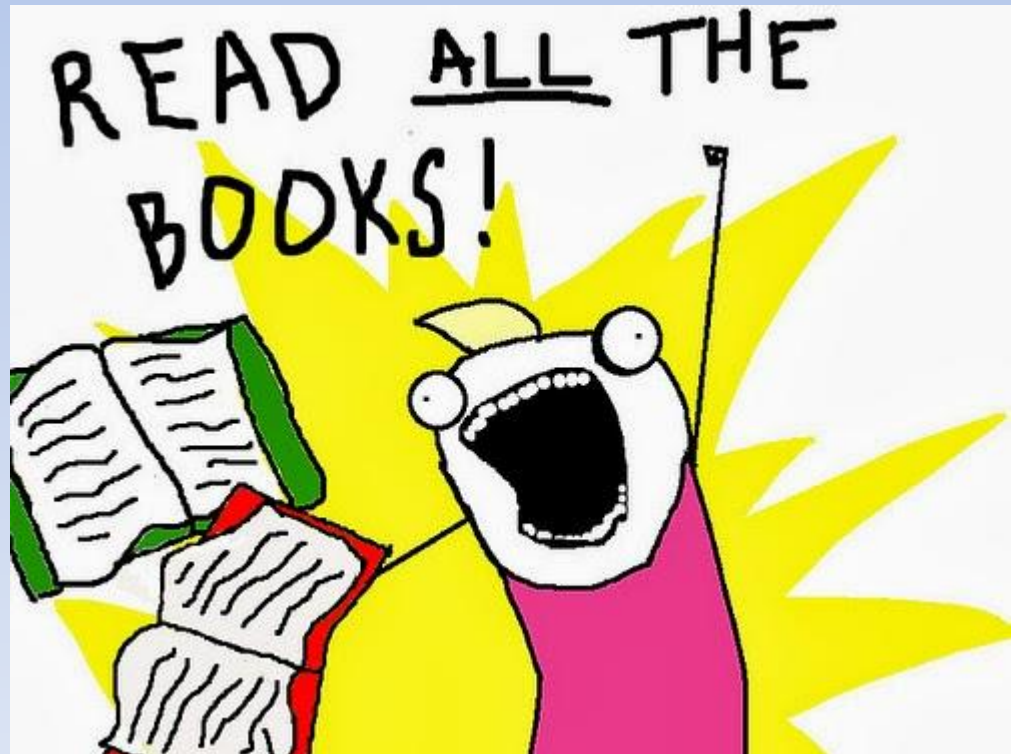
- Morning milk – letter from the office to request milk (there is a charge unless your child is on FSM)
