Important information:

At Summerville we want your child to get the best from their education. We know that attendance is a major factor which impacts directly on how well children do at school. It is a focus nationally and the aim is that more children will reach their potential through improved attendance and punctuality. **It is a parent/carer's legal responsibility to ensure your child attends school on time, every day.**

- Learning starts at 8:45am for **ALL PUPILS.**
- The gates and the doors to the school will be open from 8.30am until 8:45am; staff will be available on the gate and the doors to pass messages to teachers.
- To encourage punctuality the gates and doors will be closed and locked at **8.45am prompt.**
- Pupils who arrive after 8:45am will need to enter school via the main school entrance with an adult and sign in at the office. Your child will receive a late mark in the register.
- Any pupil arriving after 9:15am will receive an unauthorised late mark. There will be **NO EXCEPTIONS.** 10 unauthorised late marks will result in a penalty fine being issued to you.
- Holidays **WILL NOT** be authorised during term time. If you do take a holiday in term time we **WILL** apply for a penalty fine to be issued. **The Penalty Notice fine is £120.00 per parent, per child. If the penalty is still not paid within 28 days you will be prosecuted under Section 444(1) of the Education Act 1996. You will be prosecuted for failing to ensure that your child[ren] attend[s] school on a regular basis, i.e. not for the non-payment of the penalty.**
