Attendance and Punctuality

- Important that children are in school every day on time to ensure they have the best possible chance to succeed in life.
- Last academic year our whole school attendance was 92.4% putting Summerville in the bottom 10% of school's nationally.
- 23% (50) of our children had attendance of less than 90% (they missed at least 4 weeks of school).
- School will support parents/carers if they are struggling to get their child to school – just ask for help.
- We want every child to have an attendance of 95% or more.
- Lessons start promptly at 8:45 (doors open 8:30)
- Once the side doors are closed at 8:45 a late mark is recorded. If a child arrives after 9:15am they will get an unauthorised absence.
- Holidays taken in term time will not be authorised and you will receive a penalty fine of £160 (reduced to £80 if paid within a month) if they are absent from school for 5 days or more.
- Unauthorised absences of 5 days in a 10 week block will also result in a penalty fine.

Behaviour

We have 3 rules:

- Be kind
- Be safe
- Be ready

Children earn points for showing positive behaviours (Trackit Lights). Children will get certificates when they have earned 50, 100 and 200 points.

We work closely with parents/carers when children are struggling to manage their behaviour in school and will report any incidents of negative behaviour.

Free School Meals (KS2)

Even if your child has a packed lunch, if they are entitled to a benefits related free school meal please sign them up as soon as possible as school receive additional funding (pupil premium), children get free milk, school holiday vouchers and access to free holiday clubs.

If you have 'no recourse to public funds' you may be able to apply for free school meals (please contact Miss Jordan through the office for advice).

- Separate meeting to discuss this before Christmas



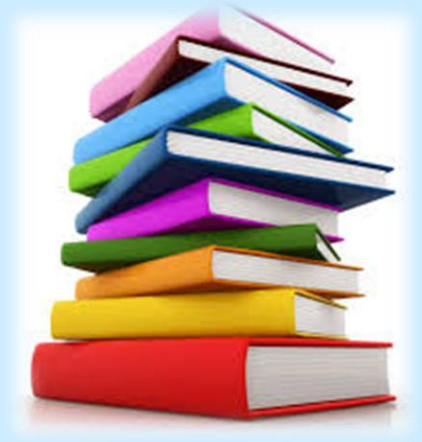
High School

Year 4

Times tables

Autumn 1

Recall multiples of 3, 4 and 8 up to $12x$ in any order, including missing numbers and related division facts fluently.

Fluently count in 6's in order up to $12x6$, using multiples of 3 to support.

Autumn 2

Recall multiples of 6 in any order, including missing numbers and related division facts with growing fluency.

Fluently count in 7's in order up to $12x7$.

Spring 1

Recall multiples of 6 in any order, including missing numbers and related division facts fluently.

Recall multiples of 7 in any order, including missing numbers and related division facts with growing fluency.

Spring 2

Recall multiples of 7 in any order, including missing numbers and related division facts fluently.

Fluently count in 9's in order up to $12x9$.

Fluently count in 11's in order up to $12x11$.

Summer 1

Recall multiples of 9 in any order, including missing numbers and related division facts with growing fluency (using $10x$ and adjusting by 1 group to find $9x$ as a strategy)

Recall multiples of 11 in any order, including missing numbers and related division facts fluently.

Fluently count in 12's in order up to $12x12$.

Summer 2

Recall multiples of 9 in any order, including missing numbers and related division facts fluently.

Recall multiples of 12 in any order, including missing numbers and related division facts with growing fluency (using $10x$ and adjusting by adding 2 more groups).

Homework

- Will be sent out to enhance and consolidate the children's learning on **Thursdays**

A mixture of the following:

- Holiday journals and activities related to topics
- SATs preparation (PiXL holiday booklets)
- Spellings – a sheet sent home each week for practise
- Please ensure your child completes any homework and returns it

PE

- Monday and Wednesday (although can change)
- PE kit on their peg (we have bought PE bags)
- Sent home for washing at the end of half term
- Black shorts/leggings, white T-shirt, trainers
- Roll-on deodorant (no aerosols)



Food and Drink

- Packed lunches – healthy packed lunches & plain water
- Morning snack – fruit or vegetables only (grapes need to be cut lengthways)
- Milk – letter via ParentPay (there is a charge unless your child is on FSM – no cash payment)



Pupil Premium Funding

- School receives £1445 for every child entitled to free school meals
- This funding provides additional staff, trips and resources to support all children in school
- Even if your child is on packed lunches, or is in Y1 & Y2 and you think your child may be eligible please let the office know and they will support you in applying
